HIGHLIGHTS

On June 4<sup>th</sup>, a domestic involving a firearm was reported in the 10000 block of North Reed Road. The initial information received was that a husband and wife were arguing, that the husband would not allow the wife to leave the home, and that the husband was armed with a handgun. The wife was eventually able to flee to a neighbor's home to seek shelter. That neighbor made contact with the husband as the husband was outdoors as well as get the handgun away from the husband. The husband, a twenty-four year old Morley man, was taken into custody and charged with domestic violence, carrying a concealed handgun in a motor vehicle, and possession of a firearm while intoxicated. The case is pending court action.
